The ranch was founded in 1882 by Karl's grandfather. This unique area creates equally unique management challenges including Grizzly and wolf populations as well as challenges and opportunities with conservation easements. The host ranch also adjoins the Bob Marshall Wilderness and the Boone & Crockett Theodore Roosevelt Memorial Ranch.
